ORDER

On February 27, 2017, William G. Yarborough, III, filed a motion for substitution of counsel, explaining he was retained by Appellant's family. On March 23, 2017, this Court sent Yarborough a letter explaining he must provide the Court with proof he served Appellant with a copy of the motion and informed Appellant he had twenty days to submit a response to the motion. The letter indicated Yarborough had ten days to provide this proof. This Court sent Yarborough a second letter on April 17, 2017, stating it had not received a response to the previous letter and asking for a response within ten days. As of May 16, 2017, this Court still has not received a response from Yarborough. Because Yarborough failed to provide proof Appellant was served with the motion, Yarborough's motion for substitution of counsel is denied and Katherine Haggard Hudgins remains as counsel.
