This is to acknowledge that on May 8, 2017, I received your letter dated May 2, 2017, requesting the Transcript of Record in the above matter. I have reviewed my records and estimate that the transcript will be approximately 27 pages.

If you desire to cancel the request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing. You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.
