I did tell Emily if she told anyone about her Mom spanking her with the switch she would be taken away from us. A couple of nights ago Lisa did spank Emily with a switch, she also slapped at her with an open hand at the back of her head at the side of her face. I never told Emily I would take Christmas away if she told. I have spanked Emily with a switch before but it was years ago, it left a red mark so I didn't do it again. Emily Aunt Jennifer has also spanked her with a switch before. Emily has a habit of lying about things. I knew Emily had marks on her from the switch but I didn't do that. My daughter, Emily, takes 2 different types of medication for ADHD and has since she was 7 years old. She also has a third medication as needed to help her sleep. My older son, Joey, is also ADHD, and he is on 3 different types of medication for his ADHD and mood swings. Last Tuesday evening after 5:00 PM, I got arrested for Driving Under Suspension and taken to jail. Once I saw the judge and got a PR bond, I called my dad to come get me, and that's when I found out that Leon got arrested for spanking Emily too hard. This was after 3:00 AM last Wednesday morning. I didn't wake Emily up to talk about it when I got home, but we talked later that morning after she woke up. She told me Leon whipped her with the back belt, and where he got the black belt from, but then she told me the sexual part about her and Leon wasn't true. She told me the only reason she said that was because she thought she would get to go live with a friend of hers if she got taken from me. I told her it doesn't work that way. Because of her ADHD, Emily acts out a lot. She lashes out at me, her brother, and other family members. I know that Leon has spanked her before with either a belt or his hand, but I have never seen him out of control when he spanks her. I have never known him to make her pull down her pants and underwear when he spanks her. When I spank her, I usually use my hand, but I never spank her when I am too mad. I have spanked her with a switch before a couple of months ago, but it was a real thin switch, and I only spanked with a switch a couple of times, and to the best of my knowledge, it didn't leave any marks on her. I did slap her in her mouth 3-4 weeks ago because she called me a real ugly name, and that may have looked to Leon like I hit her in the back of the head because she turned away from me. I have never suspected Leon of doing anything sexually with Emily. When she said something like that to my sister several years ago when my sister lived in Summerville, it didn't seem possible to me because Emily and Leon seemed close, and at that time, they were getting along really well. Leon and I have a normal sex life, and he hasn't done anything to cause me to suspect anything. When Emily got home from Summerville, I talked to her about it, and Emily said I don't why I said, and I let it go because it seemed she didn't want to talk about it. 1-2 years ago, Emily got a bruise on her shoulder when she fell at bible camp at Peace Freewill Baptist Church. One of her friends convinced her to say Leon hit her so Emily could come live with her, which meant DSS got involved, and they interviewed me, her, and church officials. DSS closed their case and told me there wasn't enough evidence to go forward. Emily has a habit of lying or changing the subject and talking real fast when I am trying to get the truth out of her. Leon takes seizure medication for a head injury from when he was an infant, but I have been with him for 9 years, and I have never seen him have mood swings or lose control. He and I argue like normal couples, but he has never been physically aggressive with me. I have asked Sgt. Kevin Bobo to prepare this statement for me, and I swear it is true to the best of my knowledge.



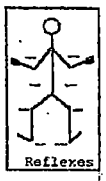

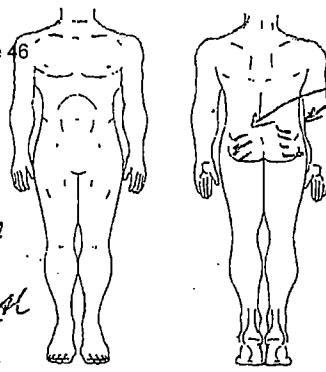

This Defendant, William Leon Burnett, pled guilty on October 4, 2012 to Unlawful Neglect of a Child and was sentenced to 10 years in prison and Criminal Sexual Conduct in the 1st degree and was sentenced to 15 years in prison, with the sentences to run concurrently. He was also ordered to register as a sex offender and to have no contact with the victim.

The Defendant's attorney subsequently filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Defendant's Sentence. This motion was granted on March 6, 2013. Both prison sentences of 15 years and 10 years, concurrent, were ordered to remain in effect. However, they were suspended to 7 ½ years in prison followed by 5 years of probation. The conditions of sex offender registration and no contact with the victim were ordered to remain in effect.

On September 1, 2016, the Defendant filed an Application for Forensic DNA Testing. The Defendant filed this motion without assistance from counsel. In his motion, the Defendant requested the results of the victim's blood tests, hair samples, urine samples and clothing samples. The Defendant alleged prosecutorial misconduct in that this information was not turned over to his defense attorney as a part of the discovery.

The victim in this case, is the Defendant's step-daughter. After her grandfather noticed bruises on her, she reported to him that the Defendant had struck her with a belt

on December 9 and December 10, 2011. The Defendant's grandfather reported the abuse to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office, and it opened an investigation.

The child was sent to the Children's Advocacy Center for a forensic evaluation. The child was interviewed on the two separate dates of December 21, 2011 and December 29, 2011. She disclosed that the Defendant would make her pull down her pants and underwear, put her hands on the wall, and then would spank her with a belt. She also said he had kissed her on the mouth and put his tongue down her throat. She said the defendant started feeling on her chest and between her legs, both inside and outside her clothing, starting in 2007 when she was 7 years old. She stated that when she was 10 years old, he started touching between her legs and began performing oral sex on her on a regular basis. She he said he also kissed and sucked on her breasts and forced her to touch his penis and buttocks. She did not allege any digital or penile penetration. She said the sexual abuse started in 2007 and continued until she was 12 years old. The victim was 12 years old at the time of her disclosure during her forensic evaluation. Both forensic interviews were turned over to the Defendant's attorney as a part of the discovery.

The Defendant was mirandized and confessed to touching the victim inappropriately about 5 times over the past 4 years. He stated that the victim was the one coming up to him, kissing him, and putting her hands down his pants. He stated that he would ask her to stop but she would refuse and would promise not to tell anyone. He said the victim also grabbed his arm and made him touch her breasts and between her legs. He said he felt sorry for her so he was trying to show her affection, and he needed help for what he had done.

Under S.C. Code Section 17-28-30(B), "a person who pled guilty or nolo contendere to at least one of the offenses enumerated in subsection (A)...is currently incarcerated for the offense, and asserts he is innocent of the offense may apply for forensic DNA testing of his DNA and any physical evidence or biological material related to his conviction or adjudication no later than seven years from the date of sentencing. Criminal sexual conduct in the first degree is one of the offenses enumerated in subsection (A).

Under S.C. Code Section 17-28-40, among other requirements, the application must "make a reasonable attempt to identify the physical evidence or biological material that should be tested and the specific type of DNA testing that is sought, explain why the identity of the applicant was or should have been a significant issue during the original court proceedings...and explain why the physical evidence or biological material sought to be tested was not previously subjected to DNA testing, or if the physical evidence or biological material sought to be tested was previously subjected to DNA testing, provide the results of the testing and explain how the requested DNA test would provide a substantially more probative result" and "explain why if the DNA testing produces exculpatory results, the testing will constitute new evidence that will probably change the result of the applicant's conviction or adjudication if a new trial is granted and is not merely cumulative or impeaching."

Under S.C. Code Section 17-28-90, "the court shall order DNA testing of the applicant's DNA and the physical evidence or biological material upon a finding that the applicant has established each of the following factors by a preponderance of the evidence: (3) the physical evidence or biological material sought to be tested is material

to the issue of the applicant's identity as the perpetrator of...the offense" and "(5) if the requested DNA testing produces exculpatory results, the testing will constitute new evidence that will probably change the result of the applicant's conviction if a new trial is granted and is not merely cumulative or impeaching."

The victim underwent a medical examination at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center on December 18, 2011. Medical staff documented the bruising on the child's buttocks, and officers took photographs of the child's bruises. The medical exam did not show any evidence of penetration or other injury to the child's vaginal area or chest area. This evidence was consistent with the child's disclosure of inappropriate touching, kissing, and oral sex. It is unlikely that these actions would leave any physical injury. Several weeks had passed since the victim stated that any sexual abuse had occurred. There was no DNA analysis performed due to the delayed disclosure. Blood tests, hair samples, urine samples, and clothing samples were not collected from the victim. The State fails to see any relevance of any of this information. The victim clearly identified the Defendant as the person who had sexually abused her. Identity was not an issue. The victim's medical records were turned over to the Defendant's attorney as a part of the discovery.

In summary, all discovery materials in this case were turned over to the defense. The information that the Defendant is currently requesting was not collected at the time of the investigation as it was not relevant. Since the victim disclosed the sexual abuse several weeks after she said the last incident occurred, no DNA would have been present and no DNA was collected from the Defendant or victim. Performing DNA analysis of

the victim and Defendant at this point, would provide no new evidence and would not be likely to affect the result of the applicant's conviction if a new trial is granted.

The State, through its undersigned attorney, Hillary C. Welborn, hereby respectfully requests that the Court rule on this matter via the written submissions from the Defendant and the State, without holding a hearing, as allowed under 17-28-50(c) of the S.C. Code of Laws of South Carolina. The State requests that the Court dismiss the Defendant's Application for Forensic DNA Testing with prejudice.






