
Dear Mr. Gill:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, you must provide an amended notice of appeal containing the correct caption as shown in the Court's attached letter. Should Gtrac Xpress, Inc., wish to be an appellant, it must be represented by counsel. As a non-attorney, you may represent only yourself in this Court.
- You must include on the notice of appeal the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal is not signed.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Please see Rule 203, SCACR. In addition to opposing

counsel, you must also file the notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.
