BRIEF FOR WRIT OF DE NOVO

I, Marsh-Davis, Juliatt am a Private American National citizen of the united States of America who privately resides in a privately domicile outside of Federal District in a non-military private estate located outside of a Federal District not subject to the jurisdiction of the "United States". I am a non-commercial, non-statutory and non-UCC person.

This is my brief for the Writ of De Novo that has been filed for case number 2017CP-08-02286 Res. The purpose and intent of this De Novo, is pretty much declared in the opening paragraph of this brief. It is improper and not equitable for an American National to be brought into the jurisdiction in which the Respondent has brought me into. It is my duty to protect my equitable rights and defenses that are not cognoscible in the current jurisdiction of the case number stated above.

As an American National the jurisdiction I should have been brought under is exclusive equity wherein my equitable rights and defenses can be recognized, as a maxim of equity, "Equity aids the vigilant, not those who slumber on their rights". Even though the Respondents may have their claim, equity will resolve the disagreements with fairness and justice, as a maxim, "Equity delights to do justice and not by halves" and "Where equities are equal, the law will prevail".

IN CONCLUSION: This is a matter of jurisdiction and trespassing of private trust, therefore it should be sealed, excluded from the public because of Special Private Priority, including but not limited to the hearing for the De Novo, and evidence revealed only in chamber. I hereby pray that this court grants the petition for the De Novo.


