ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 222 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the motion for costs filed by Ron Ork and Luke Dong is granted in part in the amount of \$1646.57 against Spartanburg Buddhist Center of South Carolina. *See Martin v. Paradise Cove Marina*, 348 S.C. 379, 384, 559 S.E.2d 348, 351 (Ct. App. 2001) (addressing Rule 222 and the limitation of its applicability to costs incurred in pursuing the appeal); *Muller v. Myrtle Beach Golf & Yacht Club*, 313 S.C. 412, 414–15, 438 S.E.2d 248, 250 (1993) (discussing circuit court's reacquisition of subject matter jurisdiction to enforce judgment and take any action consistent with the appellate court's ruling). The lower court or tribunal is directed to add this award of costs to the remittitur.
