The order was filed in December 28, 2016 in York County Court of Common Pleas. It was completed a few minutes before I arrived at the court house and was done without any argument.

A later to the Court of Appeal

I have received the file later on January 2, 2017. According to the later, I was ordered to pay \$5,456.71. However, I did not agree with it. Soon, I decided to appeal for the following reasons:

1. Mr. Joseph Toth, the man who installed the "Touch n buy" machine in my store made me sign on the paper that had no number of contract written on it and mailed me a copy of it a week later after he wrote 48 months of contract on it.
2. The machine does not work properly: it did not accept a single customer's bill payment as it is mentioned on the manual.
3. Many of the customers were not getting the prepaid phone card for the amount they want.

I had to call Mr. Joseph three to four times a day to help me fix the problems: in fact, he did not want to hear anything from me.

On top of that, he did not give me the statement that shows how much money I should have to make from the prepaid phone cards. The money for the cards sold at the store was drafted out of my bank account, but I did not get paid any amount including the \$8.00 each of the 19 government cell phones given away at the store. I lost a lot of money, and I had to pay the lease (\$92.11) a month out of pocket. I did not know what to do: my only option was to stop the machine from working.

On February 8, 2017, I delivered the copy of the appealing later to Ackerman Law of Firm P. A. office and on the same day I mailed the proof of service to The State of South Carolina Court of Appeal

Order of Transcript

On February 13, 2017, I was ordered to get a transcript from York County Court of Common Pleas. I contacted Mrs. Dallas; she agreed to transcribe the recorded audio and to send it to me in a few days. As she said it, she sent it to me in five days. The recorded audio was transcribed correctly and I mailed it to The South Carolina Court of Appeal on March 10, 2017.

Conclusion

This case needs to be justified and Mr. Joseph must take accountability for all the charge of the \$5,456.71 and the money that I should have to get paid from the prepaid phone cards and government cell phones.

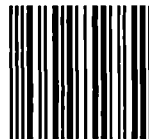
