PERSONALLY appeared before me Ernest K. Richardson, who after being duly sworn, deposes and says that:

1. I am the brother of Willie J. Richardson.

2. In late July of 1995 I was 14 years old. My date of birth is October 2, 1980. I remember my brother coming to New York for the funeral of a close friend. He arrived near the end of July of 1995. On the week-end before the birthday of my sister Michelle M. Richardson and my brother, Greg Huge, my family held a birthday party for them as my brother Greg was leaving to return to California the next week. Their birthdays are on August 15th and 14th. To the best of my recollection, the birthday party was held on Saturday August 13, 1995. My brother Willie J. Richardson was present at that birthday party.


3. At the request of C. Rauch Wise, the attorney for my brother, I was able to locate the attached photographs that were taken at that party. In one picture I can be seen with my shirt pulled up over my head. My brother Willie appears in two pictures and my mother in one picture.


4. At the time of my brother's trial on April 10-12 of 1995, I made the trip to

Lexington, SC with my mother. At that time I was 19 years old. While my mother testified I was never called as a witness for my brother. I was present in the courtroom during the testimony. Had I been called as a witness, I would have been able to confirm that my brother was in New York on the week-end of the crime he was accused of committing.

5. I do remember some discussions shortly after the birthday day party that my brother had been accused of a serious crime in South Carolina over that week-end. While I did not see him everyday when he was in New York in 1995, I do remember his carrying me shopping for school supplies in late August or early September. I do not recall his ever leaving New York from the time he arrived in late July of 1995 until September of 1995.
