MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME


number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case State v. Michael Edwards Williams with this Court on March 22, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case State v. Quartis Naquan Hemingway with this Court on March 22, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






