Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the appellate case number, the name of the Court, and the caption are incorrect. The caption on the cover page of your brief should read as follows:

Wendell Cooper, Appellant,

v.

Tom Berry and Kwik Kerb, Defendants,

Of whom Tom Berry is the Respondent.

The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. See Rule 209, SCACR. The Court cannot accept your brief without the accompanying designation of matter.

You have included attachments to your brief. Attachments are not permitted under Rule 208, SCACR. You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief, excluding the information you have named "exhibits". See Rule 210, SCACR, for the appropriate time to file this information with the Court.

You have included the statement "oral argument requested" on the cover of your brief. Any request made directly to this Court must be made in the form of a motion and must be in compliance with Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
