v.


East Coast Granite and Tile Inc., Respondent.

You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief, excluding the information you have named "exhibits". See Rule 210, SCACR, for the appropriate time to file this information with the Court.

· You have included the statement "oral argument requested" on the cover of your brief. Any request made directly to this Court must be made in the form of a motion and must be in compliance with Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
