
Dear Mr. Gries:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The binding does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR. Specifically, staples and binder clips are not acceptable.
- The document is improperly paginated, pursuant to Rule 210(c), SCACR. Specifically, only the first four pages were numbered.
- The name, address, and phone number of all counsel must appear on the cover of the record on appeal, pursuant to Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the counsel for the respondent, James Holly, was not included on the cover page.
- The cover page does not comply with Rule 267(e), SCACR: (e) Covers. Covers of the Record on Appeal and briefs shall be of a material not less than 50 pound weight and not glassine. The cover of the Record on Appeal shall be white.

- The certificate of counsel was not filed as a separate document. Specifically, it was included with the index.
