ORDER ON AMENDED MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY

On March 22, 2017, FCRE REL, LLC (“FCRE”) filed a motion requesting that the Court lift the stay so as to allow FCRE to pursue an appeal in the state of South Carolina in connection with a temporary injunction entered against FCRE and a motion and order for contempt entered in that case. The parties have agreed to this Order lifting the stay.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the automatic stay imposed by the Debtor’s filing of bankruptcy is lifted with respect to FCRE’s appeal of the temporary injunction and the granting of an Order of contempt in connection therewith. FCRE has filed a Notice of Appeal in appellate case number 2016-001899 in the South Carolina Court of Appeals and this Order allows the

Debtor and FCRE to pursue such appeal in accordance with South Carolina law and rules. No further relief from the stay is entered.
