MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Joseph C. Walker respectfully requests an extension of thirty days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Joseph C. Walker respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. On May 24, 2017, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Ryan Deleston before this Court. On May 11, 2017, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Dion Taylor v. The State with this Court. On May 5, 2017, counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in Frankie Lee Bryant v. The State with this Court. On May 3, 2017, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Wayland Purnell before the Court of Appeals. On April 26, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Mark Lorenzo Blake with the Court of Appeals. On April 25, 2016, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. George Holmes with the Court of Appeals. On April 18, 2017, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in James A. Tucker v. The State with this Court. On April 7, 2017, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Christopher Robert Murray v. The State with this Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






