MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Brian Stapleton v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on March 13, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dean Henry Cole v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on March 10, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Cathy Dawn Skates with the Court of Appeals on March 1, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Calvin Brown with the Court of Appeals on February 27, 2017.



5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




