
I, Mamie Jackson, am the Appellant in the above referenced case.

On April 13, 2017, I was arrested by the City of Columbia Police Department on a trespassing charge and my keys were confiscated by the City of Columbia and turned into their property department. The City refused to release my keys when I was released on Friday, April 13, 2017. I had to go to property on limited access hours on Tuesday of the following week. The property department refused to release by house keys where my court papers are stored, my medicines which I need on a daily basis and my personal clothes and attires. My original case file is in my house. A smaller file was in my everyday bag but was stolen from the back of my vehicle.
