Dear Ms. Kitchings:

We are in receipt of the appellant, Reginald Evans', Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension of time to file the Record on Appeal and pay his \$100.00 filing fee to reinstate his appeal. He is requesting this extension because he has multiple deadlines in other matters that fall around the same date.

The court reinstated Mr. Evans' appeal on March 31, 2017, and ordered for Mr. Evans to pay the \$100.00 filing fee to reinstate his appeal within twenty days of their Order. We do not feel that Mr. Evans has given adequate reason to why he needs an additional thirty days to pay as having multiple deadlines in other matters should not affect his ability to pay the fee.

The court further ordered on March 31, 2017, that the record on appeal shall be served and filed within twenty days of their Order. Mr. Evans has received numerous opportunities to file the record on appeal. In a letter dated November 21, 2016, the court informed Mr. Evans that the record on appeal must be served and proof of service filed within 15 days. On December 5, 2016, Mr. Evans filed a designation of matter, not the record on appeal. The court then issued a letter on January 9, 2017 giving Mr. Evans an additional ten days to file the record on appeal. Mr. Evans filed a Motion to Proceed on January 18, 2017, requesting that the court accept his record on appeal that he previously filed with the court which was not actually filed. The court dismissed his appeal on January 19, 2017 as Mr. Evans had failed to timely serve and file the record on appeal. Mr. Evans filed a Petition to Reinstate his appeal on January 27, 2017 which the court granted on March 31, 2017. At that time, the court gave Mr. Evans another twenty days to serve and file the


record on appeal. The original deadline for the record on appeal was December 5, 2017. It is now April 24, 2017, and Mr. Evans is requesting even more time to file because of other deadlines.

Therefore, we respectfully request that Mr. Evans Motion for Extension of Time be denied and that his appeal be dismissed.

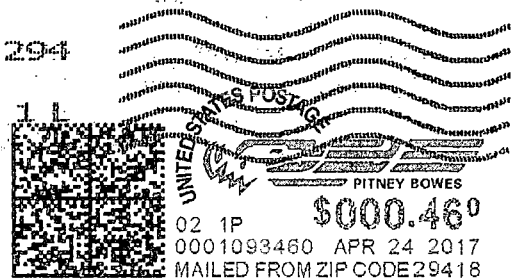
