ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter after conducting a review pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967).¹ Petitioner now seeks review of that decision.

In *State v. Lyles*, 381 S.C. 442, 673 S.E.2d 811 (2009), this Court held that it "will no longer entertain petitions for writs of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has dismissed an appeal after conducting an *Anders* review." Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
