MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Anthony M. Enriquez respectfully requests a **final two (2) day extension, until June 7, 2017**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fifth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Anthony M. Enriquez respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, **counsel will not request any further extensions and will file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation on June 7, 2017.**

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Kevin Casey v. State with the Supreme Court on May 17, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in State v. Patrick McGowan with this Court on May 11, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in State v. Gerald D. Powell with this Court on April 28, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Stephon Robinson with the Supreme Court on April 21, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Harry Lawrence Anthony v. State with the Supreme Court on April 20, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing In the matter of the care and treatment of Calvin Joe Miller with this Court on April 13, 2017.

4. This case presents a novel question, which has required extensive research by counsel. Counsel is further consulting with Chief Appellate Defender Robert Dudek, who is also managing a heavy caseload.

5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




