Dear South Carolina Supreme Court, clerk and  
other personnel. This letter is a motion to move Prose  
and give clarity that I am a prose litigant. I  
do have wishes to Add to the Appendix in this case  
on appeal and the Appeal Bond Attorney Darren  
S. Haley is not and has told me and my power  
of attorney that he is only my attorney for  
Appeal Bond. He also said that he would be  
contacting the courts now to clear this matter up  
and before he was hired I asked him would it  
be any conflict with court rules of me being

Appeal Bond counsel has not sent me one letter

Regarding anything and he definitely has made it clear that he is not my counsel on this case and in fact he instructed me how to go pro se in this case. He has told my power of attorney that he has no records involving this Appeal except which we sent him, he needs my full case files General sessions, Discovery rule five, PCR Clerk of Court records and S.C. Supreme Court records and my medical records etc At S.C. and community letter of recommendation letters to perfect this Appeal Bond. He has said that with whatever he has filed regarding the Appeal Bond that it is 3 things the court can do which is one (1) Grant the motion for Appeal Bond filed (2) Reverse motion to lower court for them to set Bond/decide (3) Order An Appeal Bond hearing... Once Again I do not have copies of my return file that I sent in, I don't have Appeal Bond motion or states return and I'm told by counsel for Appeal Bond that I Am pro se. He has not contacted me recently and never sent any letter to me and someone who is under government oath is in the wrong in my case because this is not suppose to be happening. 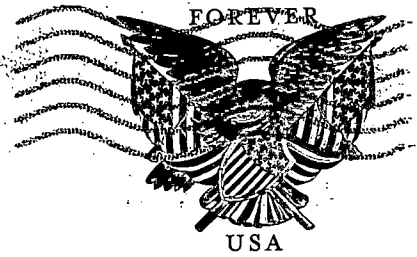
