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Dear Ms. Allen,

I received the Order issued on June 1, 2017 about what I could include in the Record of Appeal, but the emails Mr. Baxley had stated in his Designated Matter were not mentioned.

These emails (he has provided me with a copy):

2. were never entered into evidence so they do not exist in the SC Workers' Compensation Commission files, and
3. were discussed in a prior email with Ms. Bracy as not being there so they were not presented to the Commissioner.
