



GENERAL AFFIDAVIT OF MAMIE JACKSON  
June 9, 2017

The within person, Mamie Jackson, who is a resident of Richland County, state of South Carolina, personally came before me, the undersigned Notary Public and makes her statement, testimony and General Affidavit under oath or affirmation, in good faith, and under penalty of perjury, of sincere belief and personal knowledge that the following matters, facts and things set forth are true and accurate, to the best of her knowledge.

That on Friday, June 9, 2017, in answer to the call of court for case 2017-CP-40-2311 at 1701 Main Street, Richland County Circuit Court, Judge McFadden, Room 2C, my case was called. I requested that the Court order the City of Columbia to produce a return. The City Attorney Dana Thye addressed the Court that the Appeal was premature. I asked the Court to order the City to produce a return. Judge McFadden dismissed the appeal and the ordered the deputy to escort me from the courtroom. I objected as the court had not ordered the deputy to escort the two White male parties immediately before me. The deputy got in my face and grabbed my bag. I asked the Judge to order the deputy to restrain from grabbing my personal property. The Judge refused and stated that he had ruled. I voiced my intention to appeal and stated that the actions of the Court were racist as the Judge had not followed the same procedure with two White males. The Judge repeated his order. I asked for a recusal. The Judge was mute.

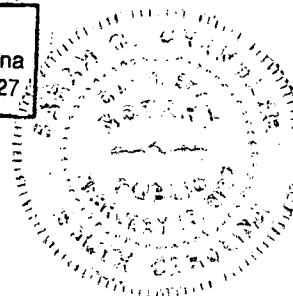
