

State in this Court on May 3, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Stanley Butler v. State in this Court on April 24, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Robert Dale Hughes in this Court on April 17, 2017. Counsel argued in the case of State v. Jonathan Xavier Miller in the South Carolina Supreme Court on April 12, 2017. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter along with the Record on Appeal in the case of State v. John Cleveland, Jr. in the Court of Appeals on April 12, 2016.

3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty-day extension, until July 12, 2017**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. Counsel requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


