PETITION TO REINSTATE APPEAL**


Pursuant to Rules 240 and 260, SCACR, Respondents Exel Inc. and New Hampshire Insurance Company hereby move this Court to deny Appellant Reginald Evans' Petition for Reinstatement of Appellant Appeal ("Petition") in the above-referenced case. This Court's May 19, 2017 Order dismissing the appeal clearly explained to Appellant that, pursuant to Rule 210, SCACR, it was his obligation to file the Record on Appeal, and that filing his Designation of Matter was not sufficient. Appellant has neither filed the Record on Appeal nor shown good cause for reinstating his appeal. He simply asserts that the Record on Appeal was filed on May 11, 2017, which is the date he filed his Designation of Matter.

CONCLUSION

For all the reasons stated herein, this Court should deny Appellant's Petition for Reinstatement of Appellant Appeal.


