


ORDER

On December 29, 2016, this Court dismissed Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals because (1) Petitioner was not represented by counsel as required in this matter by Order of this Court dated January 30, 2014; (2) Petitioner failed to file an appendix as required by Rule 242(e), SCACR; and (3) Petitioner failed to pay the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR.


Petitioner has now retained counsel to represent her in this matter. Petitioner has further filed a motion seeking to reinstate her petition for a writ of certiorari; to dispense with the requirement of filing an appendix; and to either waive the filing fee required by Rule 242(c) or, alternatively, provide Petitioner notice and an opportunity to comply with the requirement. Petitioner's motion to dispense with the requirement of an appendix is granted. Petitioner's motion to waive the filing fee is denied. We hereby grant Petitioner leave until June 28, 2017, to remit the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR. If the required filing fee is timely received, Petitioner's remaining filings will be considered on the merits. If the filing fee is not timely received, the decisions of this Court and the Court of Appeals will stand and the remittitur will be sent to the trial court.


