## ORDER

Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* was denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995) on April 7, 2017. Appellant has now filed a document entitled "Petitioner's Opposition to Court Order," which this court construes as petition to rehear the denial of his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Pursuant to Rule 240(i), SCACR, this "court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal." Accordingly, this court will take no further action on Appellant's petition to rehear the denial of his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
