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## ORDER

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In a *pro se* document dated May 24, 2017, petitioner seeks review of a circuit court order dated July 29, 2016. This document has been construed as a notice of appeal.

In response to a request from this Court, petitioner's counsel has advised that, on August 16, 2016, he received a copy of the order on appeal which had been filed with the clerk of the circuit court.
