The Appellant, hereby gives Notice of Appeal from the judgment of Benjamin H. Culbertson, Circuit Court Judge in the above action from the county of Horry, South Carolina, in the Circuit Court of Common Pleas, in the county of Horry, South Carolina.

This Notice of Appeal is made subsequent to personal notice which was received on the 15th day of May, 2017.

The appellant's exception to the judgment of the Circuit are set forth as follows:

- 1) That the Magistrate's Court previously ruled that this case was fraudulent and as such, should be dismissed.
- 2) That the Appellant in 2014 and 2015, suffered multiple strokes, and in 2016 a medical physician's report from an MRI shows a Brain Stem Stroke, hemorrhages, Cavernoma Brain Lesion. This diagnosis of this degree was unknown to the Appellant which causing multiple neurological losses including memory and attention, which ultimately precipitated her strokes. Thereafter, a car accident rendering her incapable of rendering her incompetent to sign legal

documents. That the Respondent's coerced, manipulated and used her illness to their advantage to obtain said property.

- 3) That the Appellant is under belief that the fraudulent acts of the Respondent's caused this action to have a domino effect and therefore, should be dismissed by this Court.
- 4) The Court erred in its failure to ensure that the prior rulings of said dismissal, fraudulent acts, mental and physical condition would impair and displace Appellant from her home.
