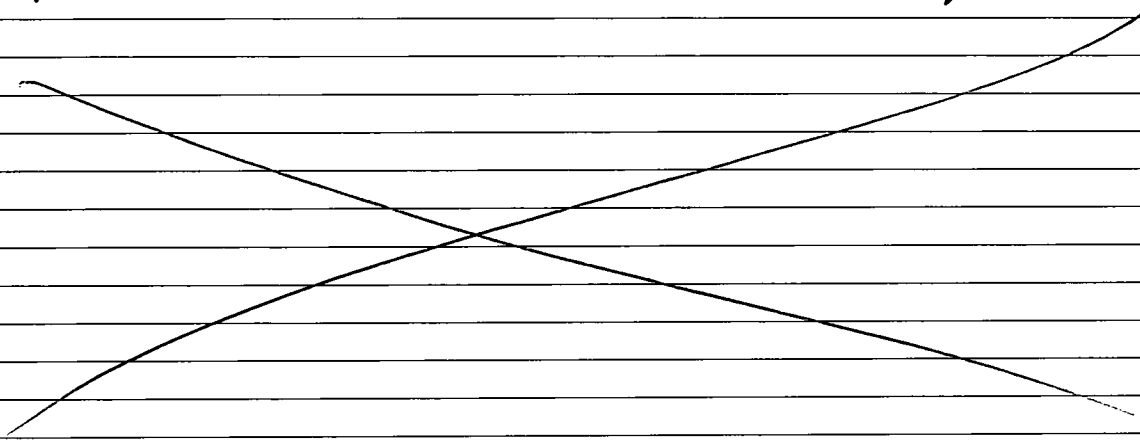

For the reasons stated, petitioner asks the Court to grant the request for appeal.

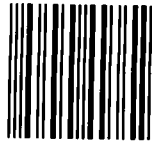

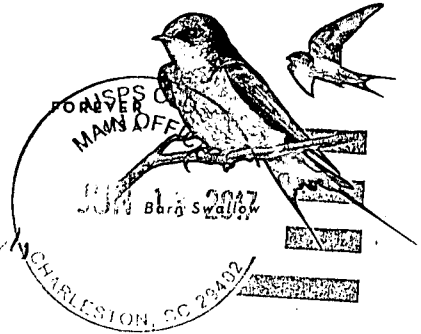
