I. - Judge Cole's Final Order of Dismissal was an 'Improper Determination' because

(a) Jones' claim of 'Newly-discovered evidence' was supported by letters showing when he received the letters, and nothing of evidentiary value was introduced into the record to rebut Jones' claim(s) of when and how he received the newly-discovered evidence that is material to guilt or innocence including the letters themselves - thus, there is a material issue as contemplated by S.C. Code Ann. § 17-27-70 (b) ("Disposition on the pleadings and record is not proper if there exists a material issue of fact."), where Judge Cole's Final Order does not show that Jones could've obtained the evidence showing Jones' actual innocence prior to the noted 'date of his first PCR'.

### CONCLUSION

• WHEREFORE, Jones submits that the above-written explanation will help this Court understand the basis of Jones' appeal of Judge Cole's Final Order of Dismissal.
