ORDER

The order of dismissal in this post-conviction relief case is dated December 9, 2008. Petitioner has filed a document dated June 12, 2017, seeking review of that order.

To the extent this document may be seeking review under Rule 243 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), an appeal has already been taken from the order of dismissal, and that appeal has been resolved. *Dukes v. State*, Appellate Case No. 2008-111307. Further, this Court has previously rejected petitioner's attempts to take a second or subsequent appeal from this order. Order dated September 25, 2014, Appellate Court Case No. 2014-001975. Since nothing in the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules allows for the filing of a second or subsequent notice of appeal from an order, the notice of appeal is hereby stricken and dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221, SCACR.

To the extent this document may be seeking relief under Rule 245, SCACR, it is stricken and dismissed since petitioner has failed to provide the filing fee and

affidavit required by this Court's order dated July 6, 2015.¹
