

**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF
MARION JAMES DODD'S
MOTION TO ALTER OR AMEND
AND AMEND PLEADINGS**

THIS MATTER initially came before me for a hearing on April 13, 2017 regarding the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment. After reviewing the motion and supporting memoranda and hearing arguments from both parties, I granted the Defendant's motion and an order was entered reflecting that ruling on May 4, 2017.

Currently before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Amend Judgment and to Amend Pleadings pursuant to Rules 59 and 15. Having considered the arguments of both parties, I do not find that the Plaintiff has provided any basis upon which the original decision of this Court should be altered. Moreover, the order entered May 4, 2017 appropriately addresses the issues raised by the Plaintiff's Motion to Amend, and therefore, I find no basis upon which the pleadings in this matter should be amended. Accordingly, the Plaintiff's Motion to Amend Judgment and to Amend Pleadings are DENIED.
