By order dated May 17, 2017, petitioner, who has filed four applications for post-conviction relief, all of which have been denied, was given twenty days to provide this Court with any reason(s) he may have why the Court should not issue an order prohibiting him from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including post-conviction relief actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to the previously filed collateral actions, challenging his murder conviction without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court. Petitioner did not respond to the order. Accordingly, we hereby impose the restrictions previously stated.
