Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, motion for stay/supersedeas, and the email received June 22, 2017, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your case may be dismissed, or your motion may not be considered:

Your email cannot be considered as a proof of service as it was not copied on the respondents. And ALL correspondence provided to the court must be served on ALL of the other parties.

We need a proof of service showing that the notice of appeal was timely served on all respondents or their counsel of record. You must include the date that the notice of appeal was first served on all respondents.

Also, we need a proof of service indicating you served all respondents with the supersedeas.

Your proof(s) of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in

Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. All proofs of service must contain the caption/title of the case, they must be signed, dated as to the date the proof of service is served, and contain the date on which the document was originally served, who was served, their mailing address, and the name of the document that was served.
