## ORDER

This court first notified Appellant that the time for serving the record on appeal had expired on January 5, 2017. After Appellant filed a motion to file the record out of time, this court granted the motion and ordered Appellant to serve the record by April 24. By letter of May 17, this court noted Appellant had not filed proof of service of the record and gave Appellant an additional ten day extension. To date, Appellant has failed to serve the record on appeal. Although Rule 207, SCACR, required Appellant to order the transcript within ten days of serving the notice of appeal, Appellant did not order the transcript until May 11, 2017, and she submitted payment to the court reporter on June 12, 2017.
