MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Samuel Brown, Jr. respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Samuel Brown, Jr. respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

State with this Court on May 17, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in State v. Patrick McGowan with the Court of Appeals on May 11, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in State v. Gerald D. Powell with the Court of Appeals on April 28, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Stephon Robinson with this Court on April 21, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Harry Lawrence Anthony v. State with this Court on April 20, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing In the matter of the care and treatment of Calvin Joe Miller with the Court of Appeals on April 13, 2017.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


