## ORDER

---

Respondent has filed a motion to strike Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter, arguing the initial brief does not include references to the record as required by Rule 208, SCACR, and the designation of matter lacks the specificity required by Rule 209, SCACR. Appellant did not file a return.

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion is granted. Within twenty days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief and an amended designation of matter. Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(4), SCACR, the amended initial brief must "contain references to the transcript, pleadings, exhibits, or other materials . . . to support the salient facts alleged. Further, the amended designation of matter must clearly identify all documents or other materials Appellant intends to include in the record. *See* Rule 209(b), SCACR.
