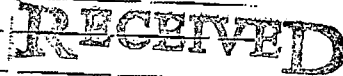

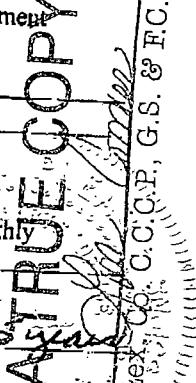

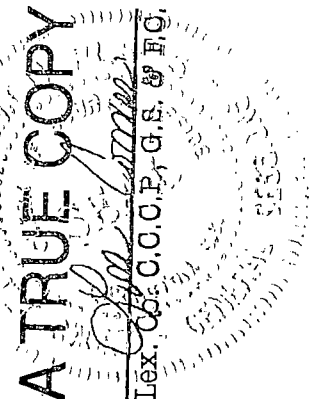

§ 16-21-80

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on May 2017 the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

That Jimmy Odell Kanipe did in Lexington County, South Carolina, on or about 11/30/2016, receive or possess a stolen vehicle, and the Defendant knew or had reason to believe such vehicle was stolen, with the value of such vehicle being more than \$2,000 but less than \$10,000, all in violation of Section 16-21-80 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976, as amended)

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
