The sentence modification of the sentence violated Constitution of United States and the South Carolina Constitution provisions against double jeopardy.

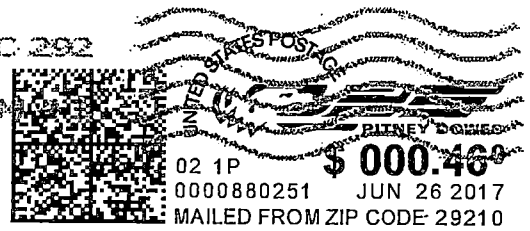
