At a Court of General Sessions, convened on May 7, 2015 the Grand Jurors of
SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE
ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT

That Matthew Corey Brogdon did in Sumter County on or about September 26, 2014, advised or agreed with or urged or hired or in some way aided, counseled or encouraged the principal felon to commit the felony of armed robbery, but was not present when the crime was committed, in violation of the Common Law and Section 16-01-0040, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO
CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY

That Whitni Milhorn did in Sumter County on or about September 26, 2014 combine with Sabrina Ann McWilliams, and/or with other persons, for the purpose of accomplishing a criminal or unlawful object or an object that is neither criminal nor unlawful through criminal or unlawful means, to wit: attempted armed Robbery, in violation of Section 16-17-410, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT THREE
BURGLARY 1ST DEGREE

That Whitni Milhorn and Sabrina Ann McWilliams did in Sumter County on or about 2014-09-26, willfully and unlawfully attempt to enter the dwelling of located at ----- Sumter, SC, without consent and with the intent to commit a crime therein, and the defendant was armed with a deadly weapon (or caused physical injury to a person or threatened the use of or displayed what appeared to be a knife or firearm), in violation of the Common Law and Section 16-11-311, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT FOUR
ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY

That Whitni Milhorn and Sabrina McWilliams did, along with co-defendants in Sumter County on or about September 26, 2014, while armed with a deadly weapon, attempt to take and carry away the personal property from or in the immediate presence of with intent to deprive him of possession by use of force, threats, or intimidation, in violation of Section 16-11-0330(B), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
