
Dear Mr. Shearouse,

I am writing to respectfully request that George Vlasis, our courier, be allowed to place the enclosed labels on the Records on Appeal adding the name of Benjamin John Tripp, of the Beaufort County Public Defender's Office (1905 Duke St, Beaufort, SC 29901) as second counsel in the above-captioned top two cases.
