Dear Mr. James:

This Court received your petition for rehearing on June 30, 2017, in an envelope showing it was received by the Kershaw Correctional Institution mailroom on June 29, 2017, and is post-marked June 29, 2017.

Since the dismissal order in this case was filed on June 13, 2017, any petition for rehearing had to be *actually received* by this Court on or before June 28, 2017. Rule 221(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Therefore, your petition for rehearing is untimely.

Further, on June 29, 2017, this Court sent the remittitur to the circuit court. Rule 221(b), SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Therefore, no action will be taken on your petition for rehearing by this Court.
