The notice of appeal indicates this appeal arises out of a guilty plea and sentence handed down on June 15, 2017. The notice of appeal was served on the State on June 29, 2017. *See* Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR ("After a plea or trial resulting in conviction or a proceeding resulting in revocation of probation, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after the sentence is imposed."); *State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 119, 784 S.E.2d 690, 692 (Ct. App. 2016) (noting service of a notice of appeal is a jurisdictional requirement and time for service may not be extended by the appellate court). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR.
