


Dear CLERK OF COURT OF APPEALS,

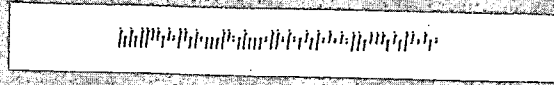

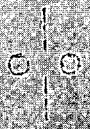
