What is the name or title of that document or page? It's not the actual order.
But when you sent the enclosed document to the SC Attorney General's Office addressed
to Assistant Deputy Attorney General Salley W. Elliott, that 1 page would have been
stamped with the date it was received. For example see my letter I sent to
Assistant Deputy Attorney General Salley W. Elliott dated October 20, 2011. It stamped
received Oct 24, 2011 Attorney General's Office, then it was routed to Tracy Meyers
(Assistant Atty General) who forwarded it to William M. Blitch for his file.

So The 2 page document I'm marked as Exhibit # 1 should be stamped
Received showing a date: just like my Oct 20 2011 letter. The 1st page
of Exhibit # 1 who have this on it, not the actual order. So when I request
from the attorney general's office, a copy of the received order denying the
petition for a rehearing in response to me, Robert Watkins Appellate Case 2008104666 of
195272, that logged in on assistant atty General William M. Blich Jr. mail log
On June 15, 2011, they should disclose to me pursuant to SC FOIA, a
copy of the received 2 page order, but because I request for a copy of the
filed April 21, 2011 order denying petition for rehearing, they tell me that they
don't have any document responsive to my request - which is true. The actual
order I'd on page 2 of Exhibit 1 enclosed would have the date it was received
on it. page 1 of Exhibit (1) would. But I don't know the title or name of that
document. This is why I'm inquiring from you, the title or name of that
document. It's evidence that William M. Blich Jr. (assist atty General) received
the order denying petition for rehearing for Robert Watkins which was filed ^{in this} ~~in the~~
mail log on June 15 2011; but what date was it received by the attorney general's
office? This is what I'm trying to find out; How can they have the order
page 2 and not page 1 of Exhibit # 1. enclosed? why would they conceal this
information? Basically assistant atty General William M. Blich Sr. Blamed
you, pursuant to Wise v South Carolina Department of Corrections 372 S.C. 173, 174
642 S.E.2d 551, 551 (2007) citing Stab v Keels 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802
(1893) for him not being ~~informed~~ provided with a copy of the SC Court of


