APPELLANT'S RETURN TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO COMPEL TO AMEND



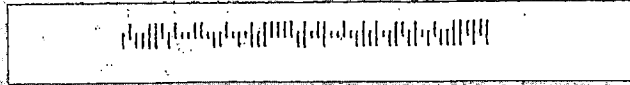
