Dear Mr. Bethea,

The department received your inquiry regarding a mobile home you used to own and a decision from the South Carolina Court of Appeals regarding that mobile home. Pursuant to an Order from the Court of Common Pleas filed on April 24, 2015, this mobile home was foreclosed on and required to be sold at public auction at the Dillon County Courthouse. Although you appealed this decision to the South Carolina Court of Appeals, they did not stay the Order from the Court of Common Pleas. Thus, when this mobile home was sold at public auction, the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles was required to transfer the title to the mobile home to the successful bidder, Federal National Mortgage Association in accordance with the Order from the Court of Common Pleas. If you have any further questions or concerns regarding the contents of the Courts' Orders, you should direct those questions and/or concerns to the Courts.

As a result of the tone of our phone conversation, any further concerns pertaining to this matter that you wish to address with the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles must be submitted to the department in writing.

Finally, as requested during our phone conversation and as promised by me, enclosed is a Tort Claim Form for you to complete and return to the address listed below. Upon receipt of the Tort Claim Form and attachments, the packet will be forwarded to our insurer, which is the Insurance Reserve Fund of the SC Department of Administration. They will have an adjuster or an investigator contact you regarding your claim. You may return the completed form along with any other documentation to the address listed below.
