MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

2. Counsel for Jarrod Jacques respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dequan Shamar Anderson v. State with this Court on May 24, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Larry James Tyler v. State with this Court on May 16, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






