

Dear McCullough:

Upon reviewing your motion to allow late ordering of the transcript, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service states that you served the appellant's petition for rehearing.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$25.00.
- You state in your letter that you have enclosed a copy of the letter you sent to the circuit court reporter ordering the transcript, but the letter was not included. You must provide this Court with a copy of your letter requesting the transcript directly from the court reporter, as required by Rule 207, SCACR.
