ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order from the Administrative Law Court (ALC) remanding the case to the South Carolina Department of Corrections. Because the order of the ALC is not a final order, we dismiss this appeal as interlocutory. *See Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Envtl. Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 267, 692 S.E.2d 894, 895 (2010) ("If there is some further act which must be done by the court prior to a determination of the rights of the parties, the order is interlocutory."). The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
